About the company

The Armidale Diocesan Investment Group (ADIG) is a registered charity with the Australian Charities and not-for-profits commission (ACNC). The ADIG started operations in 1974 to address the growing financial needs of the parishes and schools in the Catholic Diocese of Armidale, NSW.

Returns on investments with ADIG are used for charitable, religious and educational works for the communities of Armidale and Tamworth. Today, the fund has over 6,000 investors, ranging from school children and families to clubs and associations. The total fund value currently exceeds \$300 million with a capital base of over \$35 million.

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Background

ADIG's incumbent cloud services supplier was exiting the business due to financial difficulties, leaving the fund with a very short time frame to find a replacement supplier that had the necessary manpower and infrastructure to ensure quick, safe and secure migration of their entire core database. Challenges
